Pasture conditions and feeder locations should be adequate to assure that minimum consumption of supplement will be 1.34 oz. per head per day, (which will provide 60 mg lasalocid) and maximum consumption of supplement will be 4.44 oz. per head per day (which will provide 200 mg lasalocid).
