Ingredients

Cane Molasses, Cottonseed Meal, Hydrolyzed Feather Meal, Hydrolyzed Vegetable Oil, Defluorinated Phosphate, Salt, Magnesium Oxide, Calcium Iodate, Copper Sulfate, Cobalt Sulfate, Ferrous Sulfate, Manganese Oxide, Manganese Sulfate, Sodium Molybdate, Sodium Selenite, Zinc Oxide, Zinc Sulfate, Vitamin A Supplement, Vitamin D-3 Supplement, Vitamin E Supplement, Mineral Oil.

CAUTION: Follow feeding directions. **DO NOT FEED TO SHEEP.** Daily consumption of selenium should not exceed 0.7 mg per head.

Important:

DO NOT PROVIDE STARVED GOATS FREE ACCESS TO THIS BLOCK. If over-consumption occurs for more than two weeks and repositioning of the blocks does not correct the situation, remove blocks and evaluate overall feeding program.

INTRODUCTION PERIOD: During the first week of use, place the blocks approximately 50-75 feet from loafing and/or watering areas. As animals become acclimated to the presence of the block, some repositioning may be necessary to achieve proper consumption.

Feeding and Management

The Sweetlix Meat Maker™ Roughage Balancer Tub is scientifically formulated for the nutritional needs of goats. This protein and energy supplement helps goats attain maximum production by also providing complete mineral and vitamin supplementation, including copper. No additional salt or minerals are necessary.

1. Feed one tub per 10 head of goats. (This allows all animals equal access.)
2. Place the tubs where animals congregate (loafing, grazing, feeding, and watering areas).
3. Feed tubs continuously along with plentiful sources of good quality forage and clean, fresh water.
4. Goats will consume approximately 4 ounces per head per day. Four ounces of this product will supply 0.7 mg selenium.
