### **Feeding Directions:**

Johnsons Emu Starter supplies early nutrition that is essential for development into a mature bird. This 20% protein feed contains extra vitamins and minerals to reduce stress, and sickness in young birds. The minerals and vitamins will increase their immune system to fight off disease and sickness, while the extra protein will promote growth and meat production. The extra calcium will also aid in building strong bone as the bird develops. This feed also contains high percentages of the amino acid Methionine, which when deficient is the amino acid that most limits growth in Emu's. This feed is recommended for a sole ration for chicks from 3 days to 60 days in age. When birds reach 60 days of age a 7 to 10 day transition period to Johnsons Emu Grower is recommended.

### **Important management practices:**

Always provide a source of fresh, clean water, Do not allow feed to become wet or moldy. Always keep feeders and waterers clean. When changing feeds, allow a 5 to 7 day transition period. Feeding in any manner other than directed can lead to nutritional disorders. Consult an Animal Nutritionist before feeding this product in a manner other than directed.
