## FEEDING DIRECTIONS:

Feed at a rate of .1 to 1.0 lb. for every 100 pounds of body weight based upon work regimen of the individual horse. Individual horse differences may require a feeding rate adjustment of plus or minus 10% of amount indicated and can be determined by evaluating the body condition of the horse. Feed according to body condition and activity level. Always provide adequate forage and clean water. Never feed wet or moldy feed. Keep feed free from insects or rodents. Do Not Feed to Sheep due to elevated copper levels.
